OUR LINKS MISSIONARIES

Get to know Hermann and Brigitte Gschwandtner, Our LINKS missionaries for 2017-2018

Hermann and Brigitte Gschwandtner are retired missionaries from Germany. In 1990 the Church of the Nazarene asked them to start the work of the church in the Soviet Union (now CIS) and Eastern Europe. From there they moved to what is now called South Asia. The work in Bangladesh was just over a year old, and there was nothing in the other neighboring countries of Pakistan, Nepal and Sri Lanka. After 20 years of work there, the Lord blessed them with over 3,000 churches in these new countries.

The Gschwandtners used the Jesus Film, Compassionate mMnistries & child-focused community developments as tools for the Lord to transform individuals and whole families and communities in an area where over two billion people were mainly influenced by Hinduism, Buddhism and Islam.

They are now living in Germany, helping the church reach out to the floods of refugees with the love of Christ (1.2 million entered Germany in 2016).

What can we do for our LINKS (Loving, Interested, Nazarenes, Knowing and Sharing)? First, pray for them as they continue loving others in their retirement. Second, pick up a birthday card for each that we will mail in April. (Hermann's birthday is in August, Bridgette in July).
