We opened the Day Care on January 30th with four children and one teacher. We had another teacher who waited patiently for children for her class. Oh, how God has worked in the last 6 months!

As of today, August 6th, we have 27 children enrolled at Kingdom Kids. Six children have already paid their registration and curriculum fees and will start during the month of August. We only have ONE spot left in our two year old room! That will make 15 two-year-olds. We are also looking into opening a room for four

babies. We are still hiring part time teachers and have a goal of 4 full time and 3 part time teachers.

Our children know we pray for them and pray with them. When one child was out sick one day, he was informed by his friend when he came back that, "We prayed for you to get better." We had a parent attend our church who said she enjoyed it and would return.

God is moving in our center. Thank you for supporting us in this journey. Your prayers are so appreciated!
